

### Application Tips

Coverage: approx. 10m<sup>2</sup> per litre

Available in 5 and 25 litre containers

Very easy to apply. It can be used directly over old coatings.

Can be applied to planed (finished) or rough sawn timber by brush, or pump up garden sprayer.

For sheds – we recommend 2 coats are applied for the first treatment, with only one needed for future maintenance.

For fences – 1 coat will colour and weather proof with a 2nd coat deepening the shade.

Maintain every 1-2 years as required
